"Make Your Own" Study Guide:

ANGER

Below is a list of verses that in some way relates to the topic of "anger/wrath." You will have to decide what to do with these verses. In other words, you have to make your own "study guide."

You will discover that the verses provided contain a wide variety of concepts, such as:

- Verses that contain the word "anger"
- Verses that contain similar concepts (but which use different words), or actions that are the result of "anger"
- Verses that tell us what to do about such an attitude
- Verses that tell us about good types of conduct

Feel free to add other verses you may find, or remove any in the list that are not applicable to the type of outline (or study, or presentation, or whatever) you are creating. Note that the verses given below are limited to the Psalms, Proverbs, and New Testament.
