
















Down through the centuries, people have made predictions and expressed opinions.

This includes:

(occasionally) Opinions ("It might happen at this time.")

(often) Strong opinions ("It will probably happen.")

(more often) Direct claims ("It will happen.")

Those who did it:

Many were false teachers and false prophets.

Some were people who seemed to believe the Bible, but who didn't pay attention to Jesus' warning.

A few were expressing opinions, not necessarily saying "it will happen at this specific time."

Now what about the "SIGNS"?



- 1. Signs are POINTERS, reminders of what's going to happen.
- 2. They might mean "It's here" ... or not. EXAMPLES OF BOTH:
 - Perhaps 3 factors to consider: 1 the "intensity" of the

signs; (2) the response of people (repentance or not); and (3) the convergence of many signs at one time.



Regardless of what happens... our obligation is to be on guard and alert!



At the time this is being written (i.e., today), many catastrophic events are happening, or have the high potential of happening in the near future.

Down through history, there have been many disasters and cataclysmic events - both natural and man-made. Some of the worst ones occurred many centuries ago.

- ⇒ However, the potential for such disasters to occur seems
- Perhaps the "final" fulfillment will occur when <u>all</u> of these signs converge together, in unprecedented ways.

Regardless of the outcome, these signs should be viewed as reminders to keep on being ready for Jesus' coming. Besides, when the "final" signs occur, they might not match our expectations; so we might not recognize them!


The problem of making predictions (besides being false).




- People see these signs occurring and jump to the conclusion that "the end" has arrived.
- Usually, people don't do the research needed to find out if what they've heard is true. (They may also be too young to know the past... or too old to remember it!)


THE UNFORTUNATE RESULT...






















CAN WE SAY THAT ANY SIGNS ARE ACTUALLY BEING FULFILLED?

PERHAPS WE CAN:

- EXAMPLE#1: ISRAEL According to some views about end-time events, Israel must exist as a <u>nation</u> in the land of Palestine.
 - Israel is in the land something that didn't happen until 1948.
- EXAMPLE #2: THE GOOD NEWS Scripture says that the Good News will be preached throughout the world.
 - In recent decades, this has been occurring at an unprecedented rate.

"This Good News about the kingdom will be spread throughout the world as a testimony to all nations. Then the end will come."

Matthew 24:14 (GW)

WHAT CAN WE CONCLUDE?

- At the time this information was gathered, most of the "signs" do NOT seem to be any more climactic than in the recent past.
 - However, world conditions <u>do</u> appear to be getting worse. So all of this could change in a matter of weeks, days, hours, minutes, and in some cases, seconds.
 - Some signs appear to be definitely "in process" such as the increased proclamation of the Good News.

But if we obey Jesus' command to be on guard and alert,

WE WILL BE READY,

come what may!

How could things quickly change?

Today, there is the potential for so many catastrophic things to happen that were *never* possible before. Just the right set of circumstances could trigger a lot of problems. (God could also providentially "arrange" for them to all happen at once.)

- Physical threats: "Overdue" fault lines just waiting for something to trigger an earthquake; drug-resistant diseases starting to increase in number; invasive species of plants and animals, which could cause havoc on food supplies; increasing threats of war and nuclear holocaust; mass destruction of creation: etc.
- Spiritual threats: the "removal" of God from society and government; apostasy in the churches; people's dependency on the government, instead of on God; increasing lust and depravity in nations that once claimed to follow God; etc.

We DO know this much for certain:

Jesus is returning... BE ON GUARD AND ALERT!

- Different people have different views about to the end times events. But whether these views are right or wrong, this is certain:
 - Jesus told us to get ready for his return. The apostles told us to get ready. The Jews were told to get ready. Gentiles were told to get ready. So no matter who you are... <u>get ready!</u>
 - If your views about the end times leads you to think it's OK to disobey Jesus' command ... then either: ① your view is wrong; or ② you misunderstand your view.
 - The end times however they may occur are not going to develop in such a way that allows us to disobey Jesus' command to BE ON GUARD AND ALERT!

What is MY opinion of the future?

The present-day situations are different from the past. There are unprecedented changes in the world that did not exist before. This increases the likelihood that, if the signs were to intensify, it might be the "final" time.

- Use I would tend to conclude that the end is likely to be very soon. But we could be surprised... things could get even worse than we might expect. Or they might temporarily improve (perhaps like "a calm before the storm").
- This being the case, the wisest option is to wait and see... and use whatever is happening now as a reminder of what is going to happen in the future... and be ready for Jesus' return!

OUR MISSION: REMEMBER these three things... and live by them! 1. Jesus <u>is</u> coming back. 2. We don't know when. 3. We need to always be on guard and alert. Then, when the signs come, we will be ready. (If we aren't ready by then, it may be too late to get ready.)

Did you notice this emphasis on: "be on guard and alert"? Most people - even in churches - live as though Jesus will never come back - or at least not any time soon. HOW ABOUT YOU?
