

















[PARENTHESIS — 2 THINGS TO REMEMBER]

1) SALVATION INVOLVES GROWTH AND MATURITY.

4 As we grow in our salvation, the Spirit's Fruit will also grow.

5 Since growing is a lifelong process, we can always find ways to improve — doing the things that reflect the Spirit's presence. (It is our responsibility to do this.)

1 It's the ongoing absence of fruit, or continued stagnation (lack of increase), that we need to be most concerned about.

[PARENTHESIS — 2 THINGS TO REMEMBER]

2) WE CANNOT CHOOSE TO HAVE <u>SOME</u> OF THE SPIRIT'S FRUIT AND <u>IGNORE</u> OTHERS!

I WANT LOVE AND JOY, BUT <u>NOT PATIENCE AND SELF-CONTROL!</u>

This is <u>NOT AN OPTION!</u>

That would be like saying you want <u>God</u> to control part of your life, and the <u>devil</u> to control the rest!

The Spirit <u>isn't</u> willing to share your soul with the devil! So you'll have to choose one or the other.



WE SHOULD BE LOOKING FOR ...

✓ MORAL VIRTUES / CHARACTER TRAITS *

These represent the type of characteristics that will be present. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control...

Galatians 5:22-23b (NASB)

ARE THESE CHARACTER TRAITS VISIBLE IN YOUR LIFE?

- ✓ If they <u>are</u>, focus on increasing their presence in your life.
 ✓ If they <u>aren't</u>, what are you doing to grow in them?
- These traits are specifically called "fruit of the Spirit." In a more general sense, anything that the Spirit accomplishes in us can be called "fruit."

BEWARE

OF FAKE AND COUNTERFEIT "FRUITS OF THE SPIRIT"



- For EVERY godly character trait, the world/devil will invent a fake/counterfeit.
- * Make sure you pursue these character traits as defined by the BIBLE!

The devil will attempt to counterfeit EVERYTHING that the Spirit does in your life. Only by knowing Scripture will you be able to know if it is actually from God.

AVOIDING THE WORLD'S FAKES

EXAMPLE #1 – <u>JOY</u> that comes from God

It's NOT based on circumstances, but can exist in difficult situations.

JOY FROM THE SPIRIT
WILL INFLUENCE YOUR
ATTITUDE TOWARD
SUFFERING

So you received the message with joy from the Holy Spirit <u>in spite of the severe</u> <u>sufferina</u> it brought you. In this way, you imitated both us and the Lord.

1 Thes. 1:6 (NLT)

THIS IS HOW PAUL
DESCRIBED HIS SITUATION

... as sorrowful yet always rejoicing, ...

2 Cor. 6:10a (NASB)

[He didn't pretend the sorrow didn't exist.]

AVOIDING THE WORLD'S FAKES

EXAMPLE #2 – <u>LOVE</u> that comes from God A desire for the long-term good of others; based on the nature and actions of God.

A concern for their well-being, regardless of how they respond back.

IT APPLIES
EVEN TO ENEMIES

But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be children of your Father in heaven.

Mt 5:44-45a (CSB)

EXAMPLES OF HOW PAUL EXPRESSED LOVE IN DIFFICULT SITUATIONS When we are verbally abused, we respond with a blessing, when persecuted, we endure, when people lie about us, we answer in a friendly manner.

1 Co 4:12b-13a (NET)

ANOTHER TYPE OF "FRUIT" THAT WILL BE PRESENT:

(= The results of the Spirit's presence)

✓ CAPABILITIES, ABILITIES FOR BUILDING-UP OTHERS

THE SPIRIT GIVES US ABILITIES –

NOT FOR OURSELVES, BUT FOR
BUILDING UP THE WHOLE GROUP

There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit.

Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.

1 Cor. 12:4, 7 (NIV)

WE, AS THE "BODY OF CHRIST,"
ARE TO WORK TOGETHER, SO
THAT WE, AS A GROUP, GROW

As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is healthy

and growing and full of love.

Ephes. 4:16b (NLT)

SHARING OUR ABILITIES WITH OTHERS

- ➤ THE SPIRIT GIVES EACH OF US ABILITIES.
 - ✓ Some may be quite visible, others will be "behind the scenes."
 - ✓ Some may have a greater focus on spiritual needs; others will be more focused on material needs.
- ➢ GOD DOES NOT INTEND FOR US TO DO EVERYTHING BY OURSELVES ─ AS INDIVIDUALS ACTING ALONE!
 - ✓ We need to recognize the abilities of others, and let them do their part!
 - Encourage others to do their part, instead of trying to do it for them!

ANOTHER "FRUIT" OF THE SPIRIT'S PRESENCE:

✓ Power

Everything that God commands us to do... the Spirit EMPOWERS us so we can do it.

... a demonstration of the Spirit's **power**, ... 1 Cor. 2:4b (NIV)

POWER TO OBEY GOD

And I will put my **Spirit** in you so you will obey my laws and do whatever I command.

Ezekiel 36:27 (NLT)

POWER THAT INFLUENCES OUR
CONDUCT

For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline.

2 Tim. 1:7 (NLT)

ARE THERE EVEN MORE "FRUIT"? YES!

- THERE IS SO MUCH MORE that the Spirit does in the life of Jesus' followers! (This was just a short overview.)
 - Grows us in our salvation; makes us holy.
 - · Guides us; restrains us; convicts us of sin.
 - · Makes us able to live as a child of God.
 - Teaches us through God's Word.
 - Bears witness to our salvation (when these expressions of the Spirit are growing in our lives).
 - · Enables prayer (also prays in our behalf).

Every aspect of life is either influenced by the Spirit... or by the sinful nature.



THE KEY ISSUES TO FOCUS ON:





When the Spirit is at work in our lives, his work will be visible. It will influence how we think and how we live!

✓ THIS MEANS (if we want to call ourselves Jesus' followers) WE HAVE AN OBLIGATION:

So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will <u>not gratify</u> the desires of the <u>sinful nature</u>.

Galatians 5:16 (NIV)

Since we live by the Spirit, let us <u>keep in step</u> with the <u>Spirit</u>.

Galatians 5:25 (NIV)
