KINGDOM QUESTIONS

- WERE THE JEWS <u>WRONG</u> IN WANTING THEIR KINGDOM TO BE RESTORED?
- The problem wasn't their <u>desire</u> for a kingdom; but rather, the <u>type</u> of kingdom they desired.
- They wanted a kingdom on <u>their</u> terms, to accomplish <u>their</u> objectives. They didn't want to make the life changes necessary for entering <u>God's</u> kingdom.

WHAT TYPE OF KINGDOM SHOULD THEY HAVE WANTED?

- Even in the Old Testament era, kings were to rule <u>under God</u>. They were to follow the leading of God's prophets.
- Ultimately, the people were to serve <u>God</u> with all their hearts. They failed to do this – both in the Old Testament and in Jesus' day. (Had they done so, they would have accepted the Good News of "the Kingdom of God" that Jesus proclaimed.)

WILL THE JEWISH KINGDOM BE RESTORED?

- Many of the prophets tell of a future time when the kingdom will be restored.
- God's Old Testament promises will be fulfilled and probably in greater ways than we might expect. But this will not happen until the Jews wholeheartedly return to the God of the kingdom, and to Jesus the Messiah, the Son of David, who is the King of the kingdom.

HOW MIGHT THE FUTURE KINGDOM BE <u>DIFFERENT</u> FROM WHAT THE JEWS WERE LOOKING FOR IN JESUS' DAY?

- In the future, the kingdom will be comprised of saved people both Jew and Gentile.
- Instead of the Jew's enemies all being <u>destroyed</u> (as the Jews wanted), many will be <u>saved</u>, and become part of the kingdom!

Right now, <u>our</u> kingdom focus is related to the work of Jesus in the lives of people – both Jew and Gentile. As the apostles were told, we don't have to worry about what God plans to do in the <u>future</u>. God has given us a job to do <u>now!</u> ... the apostles ... asked him, "Lord, is this the time when you're going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" Jesus told them, "You don't need to know about times or periods that the Father has determined by his own authority.

WHAT SHOULD OUR FOCUS BE, RIGHT NOW?

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes to you. Then you will be my witnesses to testify about me in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."
